- ICT and digital literacy classes for youth, women, and caregivers.

- Content creation, data collection, and reporting by trainers.
- Access to online resources, educational videos, and e-learning platforms.

By integrating laptops into these projects, HRA will enhance **education quality, digital access, and refugee self-reliance**, creating lasting opportunities for health, skills, and livelihoods.
